MENDOCINO COMPLEX FIRE REPOPULATION

WHAT: REPOPULATION
WHEN: AUGUST 1, 2018 at 12:30 P.M.
WHERE: Evacuation orders have been reduced and residents may return to the following areas:

- Hopland Area- Highway 175; east of mile marker 5.6, west of the Mendocino Lake County line, north of Highway 175, south of current fire perimeter.

The Mendocino County Sheriff's Office has reduced the Mandatory Evacuation to an Evacuation Warning in the following areas:

- Hopland Area- Highway 175; east of mile marker 5.6, west of the Mendocino Lake County line, north of Highway 175, south of current fire perimeter.

A road Closure remains at mile maker 5.6 on Highway 175 to east bound traffic. Only residents with valid ID will be allowed through.

NOTES: **SAFETY MESSAGE** – The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. Please continue to adhere to road closures and any evacuation warnings. A reminder to drive slowly and yield to emergency personnel in the area. There will be smoke in the respective areas as firefighters continue firefighting operations. If at any time you feel unsafe, please call 911.

Residents may experience very smokey conditions as the firefight continues. Smokey conditions can be unhealthy to many people especially children, the elderly, and anyone with respiratory problems.
