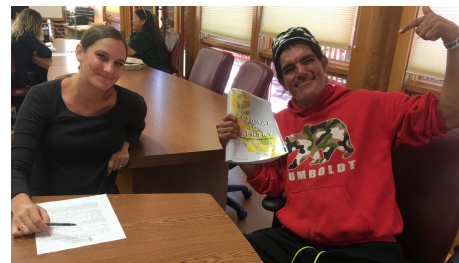

At the clinic, we will be providing record-cleaning services and legal information about navigating barriers because of your record related to employment, housing, public benefits, family & children, immigration, parole & probation, getting an ID and drivers license and more!

TRAINING: At the HSU training, you will learn to better understand your employment rights as someone living with an arrest and conviction record in California. We will also discuss how to navigate criminal fines, fees and restitution.

WHAT TO BRING: If possible, please bring a "RAP sheet" (a copy of your criminal record) for full record-cleaning services and any other paperwork related to your legal questions.
