
The defendant having been released on bail in the above-captioned and numbered felony case, it is now asserted that the defendant has failed to obey all laws while on that bail, as follows:

The Mendocino County District Attorney's Office has received a crime report from the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office containing information sufficient for the District Attorney to approve the filing of a criminal complaint charging the defendant with a felony violation of section 594(b)(1) of the Penal Code and four counts of a misdemeanor violation of section 452(d) of the Penal Code. These crimes occurred on or about 12/19/2021.

Wherefore, as a result of the defendant's new criminal misconduct, the Mendocino County District Attorney respectfully requests that the defendant's bail be revoked and be remanded into custody.
