**THE UNDERSIGNED, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF, COMPLAINS AND SAYS,
THAT WITHIN THE COUNTY OF MENDOCINO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

COUNT ONE

Said defendant **STEVEN FRANCIS RAMIER** did on or about the 4th day of November 2020, commit the crime of RECKLESS DRIVING WHILE EVADING A PEACE OFFICER, a FELONY violation of Section 2800.2(a) of the California Vehicle Code, in that said defendant while operating a motor vehicle in a willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property did then and there intent to evade, flee or otherwise elude a pursuing peace officer in violation of Section 2800.1;

COUNT TWO

Said defendant **STEVEN FRANCIS RAMIER** did on or about the 4th day of November 2020, commit the crime of DRIVING ON A HIGHWAY IN A DIRECTION OPPOSITE THE TRAFFIC WHILE EVADING A PEACE OFFICER, a FELONY violation of section 2800.4 of the California Vehicle Code in that said defendant did then and there drive a motor vehicle in a direction opposite to that of traffic while evading, fleeing or otherwise eluding a pursuing peace officer in violation of Section 2800.1.

STRIKE ALLEGATION

It is further alleged that the defendant **STEVEN FRANCIS RAMIER**, did prior to the commission of the above offense suffer a conviction for the crime of ROBBERY, a felony violation of Section 211 of the California Penal Code, in the Superior Court of the State of California in and for the County of Mendocino, on or about the 13th day of November 2007, within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 1170.12 and 667.

COUNT THREE

Said defendant **STEVEN FRANCIS RAMIER** did on or about the 4th day of November 2020, commit the crime of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, a MISDEMEANOR violation of Section 11377(a) of the California Health & Safety Code in that said defendant did then and there have in his possession a controlled substance, to wit, METHAMPHETAMINE.

The offenses charged in the **THREE COUNTS** of this complaint were of the same class of crime or connected together in their commission.


Complainant therefore prays that said defendant be dealt with according to law.
