Public Notice: Staff with the Mendocino County home visiting program recently identified "recalled" cans of infant formula in local communities.

The U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) is warning consumers not to use certain powdered infant formula produced in Abbott Nutrition's facility in Sturgis, Michigan. Contaminated infant formula may have contributed to one infant death and four illnesses across three states. FDA is advising consumers not to use Similac, Alimentum, or EleCare powdered infant formulas if:

- the first two digits of the code are 22 through 37; and
- the code on the container contains K8, SH or Z2; and
- the expiration date is 4-1-2022 (APR 2022) or later
